


Interested in offering a short-term rental for the Total Solar Eclipse?


In this step, we'll ask you which type of property you have and if guests will book the entire place or just a room. Then let us know the location and how many guests can stay.





How to set up a payout method

Desktop iOS app Android app Mobile browser

- 1. Go to Account > Payments & payouts > Payouts
- Click Set up payouts (Add payout method, if you already have an existing payout method)
- 3. Choose your billing country/region to find payout methods available to you.
- 4. Select the type of payout method you want to use, then click Continue
- 5. Add the requested info, then click Next

If you've set up more than one payout method, you can choose a default.
